Lesson 1: The Four Operations of the Mind

The simple contemplation of **ideas** offered to our mind without affirming or denying anything about them.

Where we join two or more ideas together by affirming or denying something about them. *This horse is fast.* This result of judgment is called a **proposition** (something is proposed) or **argument**.



(also called Reasoning) Where we take two or more **propositions** that are already known and evident, and draw a third idea - a **conclusion**.

[1] Our Creator must be worshipped; [2] God is our Creator:

[3] therefore, God must be worshipped



How we arrange ideas, propositions, and arguments in order to gain the clearest knowledge of them and best remember them.
